## **Executive Summary** – Wayne Saunders. (Player, Coach, Umpire, Administrator)



In 2023, Wayne completed 65 consecutive active years in softball. Starting with Hutt City United as a junior player in 1957 through to captain of the Major Reserve and Major A teams before starting his umpiring career in 1976.

In 2023, after 18 years' service, Wayne retired as the WBSC Regional Umpire Coordinator for Oceania. During this time he was Co-chair/Team Leader of the WBSC Playing Rules Re-Write Commission, Chaired the WBSC Reformatted Casebook Re-write and field mechanics committees.

Internationally, Wayne has served as Assistant Umpire Director/Umpire-in-Chief at the last five WBSC Men's World Cups/World Championships (2013, 2015, 2017, 2019, 2022) and Women's World Championship in 2018. 2022 was Wayne's 11<sup>th</sup> Men's World/World Championship in an official capacity.

He has on-field officiated at nine WBSC-SD International Tournaments including the Athens Olympic Games, Europe/Africa Olympic Qualifier and seven ISF World Championships including a Women's, a Junior Men's, a Junior Women's and four Men's Championships totalling 135 games, his last game being the Gold Medal Game at the Athens Olympics.

Other major International appointments included the ISF Prague Softball Cup, Prague, Czech Republic; 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> Canada Cups, Vancouver, Canada; Blacktown International Challenge, Sydney, Australia; ISC World Tournament, Kitchener, Ontario, Canada; totalling 41 International Tournaments or Test Series. Umpiring 505 International/Overseas games, including 248 full Internationals involving 44 different nations.

In 2015 Wayne completed 20 years' service as a member of the New Zealand National Staff, including 10 years as Umpire-in-Chief. In 2009 Wayne retired as an active field umpire after 35 years of on-field officiating. He had been appointed to 81 New Zealand National Tournaments since 1977 and has worked 47 National Tournament Grand Finals. Additionally, Wayne had supervised 31 National, and numerous local tournaments and Internal International series.

Wayne is an elected member of the World Baseball Softball Confederation's and Softball New Zealand's Halls of Fame. A finalist in the Official of the Year category at the Annual Sport Wellington Region Sportspersons on five occasions and was the winner of the award in 2004 and 2005. Wayne is a Life Member of the Hutt Valley Softball Association, Hutt Valley Softball Umpires Association and the Hutt City United Softball Club. Wayne serves as the Patron of his Hutt City United club, President of his local Hutt Valley Umpires association and as a WBSC Umpire Commissioner.
