### Game Highlights:

This was a game of 6 + 1 innings: the New Zealand team held the Australian team to within 2 runs until the last inning. In the end a little inexperience cost the team dearly with 3 expensive runs scored, effectively quashing their chance to come back and win. Taylor-Paige Stewart had an outstanding performance on the mound, remaining composed throughout. This was particularly impressive given her young age, and she appears to be a star in the making. There were three game-changing moments: in the 4<sup>th</sup> inning, Lara Andrews took a diving catch and turned it into a double play with a quick throw to 3<sup>rd</sup> to finish the innings after Australia had loaded bases with 1 out; in the 5<sup>th</sup> inning, Taylor-Paige Stewart caught a low line drive on the pitchers mound and combined with Rebecca Bromhead at 1<sup>st</sup> to turn it into a double play; in the 7<sup>th</sup> inning, Michal Tangaroa hit a stand-up double to deep left-centre to score Lara Andrews for New Zealand's only run of the game. After the game, the Australian coach noted that it was one of New Zealand's best performances against them in recent years.
