Game Highlights:

New Zealand looked flat in the field, and Canada jumped on top early with runs in each of the first 3 innings, including an automatic home run off the first pitch of the game. Although there was only 1 New Zealand error in the field, they made some costly mental mistakes. New Zealand did have a few good opportunities with the bat, but they did not capitalise until the 5th inning, when they scored 1 run after having loaded bases and none out. Te Reo Powhiri Matautia was the hot hitter for New Zealand with 2 hits, including an RBI single, and a walk. Replacement 2nd base Danica Ferriso and replacement pitcher Megan Farrell also had 1 hit each. Megan Farrell made an immediate impact on the mound when she entered in the 3rd inning, stopping a 4-run Canada rally. In the field, replacement right fielder Robyn Hall made a good sliding catch and almost got the runner advancing to 3rd base with an accurate throw.
